The objective of this document is to provide requirements for the safe operation, inspection and maintenance of steel storage racking. Storage racking invariably coexists with material handling equipment. This document aims to minimize the risks associated with the unsafe use of steel storage racking.

AS 4084:2012 has been revised and divided into two parts. This document forms part of the AS 4084 series on steel storage racking.
