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## PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Standards Australia Committee CE-029, Access Covers and Grates, to supersede AS 3996—2006.

*This Standard incorporates Amendment No. 1 (March 2021). The changes required by the Amendment are indicated in the text by a marginal bar and amendment number against the clause, note, table, figure or part thereof affected.*

The objective of this Standard is to provide designers, manufacturers and purchasers of access covers and grates with a specification for design, supply and testing.

This revision has been made to improve performance of trafficable covers and grates, to provide a method of testing uplift and to include specific requirements for composite materials.

The terms ‘normative’ and ‘informative’ are used in Standards to define the application of the appendices to which they apply. A ‘normative’ appendix is an integral part of a Standard, whereas an ‘informative’ appendix is only for information and guidance.

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
