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Preface

This Standard was prepared by the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee EL-031, Intruder Alarm Equipment and Installations.

The objective of this Standard is to introduce general requirements on video transmission. This Standard covers the general requirements for video transmissions on performance, security and conformance to basic IP connectivity, based on available, well-known, international standards.

This Standard is an adoption with national modifications, and has been reproduced from, IEC 62676-1-2:2013, *Video surveillance systems for use in security applications — Part 1-2: System requirements — Performance requirements for video transmission*. The modifications are additional requirements and are set out in [Appendix ZZ](#), which has been added at the end of the source text.
