### **Preface**

This Standard was prepared by the Australian members of the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee TX-009, Carpets, to supersede, AS/NZS 2455.1:2007, *Textile floor coverings—Installation practice, Part 1: General.* 

After consultation with stakeholders in both countries, Standards Australia and Standards New Zealand decided to develop this Standard as an Australian Standard rather than an Australian/New Zealand Standard.

The objective of this Standard is to provide contractors, manufacturers, suppliers, and purchasers of textile floor coverings, and others (for example, technical educators) with a best-practice guide to enable the provision of correctly installed textile floor coverings.

This revision was undertaken to update systems of installation and preparation.

The AS 2455 series of Standards comprises the following parts:

AS 2455.1, Textile floor coverings—Installation practice, Part 1: General (this Standard)

AS 2455.2, Textile floor coverings—Installation practice, Part 2: Carpet tiles

NOTE Requirements for installing carpet tiles are covered in Part 2 of this Standard.

The terms "normative" and "informative" have been used in this Standard to define the application of the appendices to which they apply. A "normative" appendix is an integral part of a Standard, whereas an "informative" appendix is only for information and guidance.
