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PREFACE

This Standard was prepared by the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee MT-009, Metal Finishing, to supersede AS/NZS 2728:2007, *Prefinished/prepainted sheet metal products for interior/exterior building applications—Performance requirements*.

The objective of this Standard is to specify the requirements for prefinished sheet and strip intended for fabrication into products for use in the building industry.

No international (ISO) Standards are available on this subject.

The terms ‘normative’ and ‘informative’ have been used in this Standard to define the application of the appendix to which they apply. A ‘normative’ appendix is an integral part of a Standard, whereas an ‘informative’ appendix is only for information and guidance.

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
