### Preface

This Standard was prepared by the Joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee EL-004, Electrical Accessories, to supersede AS/NZS 61058.1:2008, *Switches for Appliances, Part 1: General requirements* on the date of publication.

A This Standard incorporates Amendment No. 1 (June 2021). The start and end of changes introduced by the Amendment are indicated in the text by tags including the amendment number 1.

The objective of this Standard is to specify general electrical safety requirements for switch appliances provided with additional control functions governed by the switch provided with electronic circuits and devices that are necessary for the intended and/or correct operation of the switch.

This Standard does not apply to cord-line switches within the scope of AS/NZS 3127.

The major changes in this edition are as follows:

- (a) Extends the scope of application for switches to be operated by—
  - (i) a person via an actuating member;
  - (ii) indirect actuation; and
  - (iii) an actuating sensing unit.
- (b) Includes significant technical changes:
  - (i) Requirements for mechanical switches are now given in AS/NZS 61058.1.1 (4); and
  - (ii) Requirements for electronic switches are now given in  $\mathbb{A}$  AS/NZS 61058.1.2  $\mathbb{A}$ .

This Standard is an adoption with national modifications, and has been reproduced from, IEC 61058-1:2016, *Switches for appliances — Part 1: General requirements*.

<u>Appendix ZZ</u> lists the variations to IEC 61058-1:2016, for the application of this Standard in Australia and New Zealand.

As this document has been reproduced from an International Standard, the following applies:

- (i) In the source text "this part of IEC 61058" should read "this Australian/New Zealand Standard".
- (ii) A full point substitutes for a comma when referring to a decimal marker.

Australian or Australian/New Zealand Standards that are identical adoptions of international normative references may be used interchangeably. Refer to the online catalogue for information on specific Standards.

The terms "normative" and "informative" are used in Standards to define the application of the appendices or annexes to which they apply. A "normative" appendix or annex is an integral part of a Standard, whereas an "informative" appendix or annex is only for information and guidance.
