Forfás in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (3) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Industrial Development Act, 1993 (No. 19 of 1993), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (EDI - Message - Quantity valuation message (CONQVA)) Declaration, 1995.
2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for EDI - Message - Quantity valuation message (CONQVA). The Schedule comprises the text of EN 1480: 1995.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN 1480:1995 or as I.S./EN 1480:1995.
