NSAI in exercise of the power conferred by section 16 (3) of the National Standards Authority of Ireland Act, 1966 (No. 28 of 1996) and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Aerospace series - Bolts, MJ threads, in heat resisting nickel base alloy NI-PH2601 (Inconel 718) - Classification: 1 275 MPa (at ambient temperature) / 650°C - Technical specification) Declaration, 1997.
2. (1) The Specification set forth in the schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Aerospace series - Bolts, MJ threads, in heat resisting nickel base alloy NI-PH2601 (Inconel 718) - Classification: 1 275 MPa (at ambient temperature) / 650°C - Technical specification. The Schedule comprises the text of EN 2583:1997.
