Forfás in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (5) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Industrial Development Act, 1993 (No. 19 of 1993), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Quality Management and Quality Assurance Standards – Part 1: Guidelines for Selection and Use (ISO 9000-1:1994)) Declaration, 1994.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Quality Management and Quality Assurance Standards – Part 1: Guidelines for Selection and Use (ISO 9000-1:1994). The Schedule comprises the text of EN ISO 9000-1 : 1994.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard EN ISO 9000-1:1994 or as I.S. EN ISO 9000-1:1994.

3. (1) The Standard Specification (Quality Management and Quality Assurance Standards – Guidelines for Selection and Use) Declaration, 1989, is hereby revoked.

(2) Reference in any other standard specification to the Instrument hereby revoked and to Irish Standard/ISO 9000/EN 29000 : 1989, thereby prescribed, shall be construed, respectively, as references to this Instrument and to Irish Standard EN ISO 9000-1:1994.
