Together with existing common modifications in EN 60570:1996, it was approved by CENELEC as EN 60570 on 2003-03-18.

This European Standard supersedes EN 60570:1996 + A1:1998 + A2:2000 and EN 60570-2-1:1994 + A1:1996.
