Forfás in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (3) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Industrial Development Act, 1993 (No. 19 of 1993), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Aerospace series - Fibre reinforced plastics - Determination of water absorption by immersion) Declaration, 1996.
2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Aerospace series - Fibre reinforced plastics - Determination of water absorption by immersion. The Schedule comprises the text of EN 2378 : 1995.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN 2378:1996 or as I.S./EN 2378:1996.
