The Schedule comprises the text of ENV 41509:1990.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/ENV 41509 : 1991 or as I.S./ENV 41509 : 1991.

This European Prestandard (ENV) was accepted by CEN/CENELEC on 1989-10-19 as a prospective standard for provisional application. The period of validity of this ENV is limited initially to three years. After two years the members of CEN/CENELEC will be requested to submit their comments, particularly on the question whether the ENV can be converted into an EN.

CEN/CENELEC members are required to announce the existence of this ENV in the same way as for an EN and to make the ENV available promptly at national level in an appropriate form. It is permissible to keep conflicting national standards in force (in parallel to the ENV) until the final decision about the possible conversion of the ENV into an EN is reached.

CEN/CENELEC members are the national standards organizations and national committees, respectively, of Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and United Kingdom.

BRIEF HISTORY

This European Prestandard (ENV) was elaborated by the EWOS Expert Group ODA and submitted by the CEN/CENELEC Central Secretariat to the members for Formal Vote on 29 March 1989. It was approved with a number of technical and editorial comments, which were discussed by the Expert Group on 19 October 1989. The resulting amended version was adopted at a CEN/CENELEC voting meeting on the same day, where the following member countries voted for its acceptance: Belgium, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, United Kingdom.
