1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Acoustics - Measurement of sound insulation in buildings and of building elements - Part 4: Field measurements of airborne sound insulation between rooms (ISO 140-4:1998)) Declaration, 1999.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Acoustics - Measurement of sound insulation in buildings and of building elements - Part 4: Field measurements of airborne sound insulation between rooms (ISO 140-4:1998). The Schedule comprises the text of EN ISO 140-4:1998.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard EN ISO 140-4:1999 or as I.S. EN ISO 140-4:1999.
