BAR CODED TRANSPORT AND HANDLING LABELS FOR STEEL PRODUCTS

EOLAS - The Irish Science and Technology Agency in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (3) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Science and Technology Act, 1987 (No. 30 of 1987), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Bar Coded Transport and Handling Labels for Steel Products) Declaration, 1993.
2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Bar Coded Transport and Handling Labels for Steel Products. The Schedule comprises the text of ENV 606 : 1992.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/ENV 606 : 1993 or as I.S./ENV 606 : 1993.

This European Prestandard (ENV) was approved by CEN on 1992-08-19 as a prospective standard for provisional application. The period of validity of this ENV is limited initially to three years. After two years the members of CEN will be requested to submit their comments, particularly on the question whether the ENV can be converted into an European Standard (EN).

CEN members are required to announce the existence of this ENV in the same way as for an EN and to make the ENV available promptly at national level in an appropriate form. It is permissible to keep conflicting national standards in force (in parallel to the ENV) until the final decision about the possible conversion of the ENV into an EN is reached.

CEN members are the national standards bodies of Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and United Kingdom.
