1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Information Technology – International Standardized Profiles AOM1n OSI Management Communications – Part 1: Specification of ACSE, Presentation and Session Protocols for the Use by ROSE and CMISE (ISO/IEC ISP 11183-1:1992)) Declaration, 1995.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Information Technology – International Standardized Profiles AOM1n OSI Management Communications – Part 1: Specification of ACSE, Presentation and Session Protocols for the Use by ROSE and CMISE (ISO/IEC ISP 11183-1:1992)). The Schedule comprises the text of EN ISP 11183-1 : 1994.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN ISP 11183-1:1995 or as I.S./EN ISP 11183-1:1995.
