## Preface

This Part of I.S. 325 is a code of practice dealing with the materials and workmanship aspects of masonry construction. The structural design of unreinforced masonry is dealt with in I.S. 325:Part 1. It was prepared under the direction of the National Standards Authority of Ireland.

I.S. 325:Parts 1 and 2 are based on BS 5628:Parts 1 and 3 respectively. The preparation of I.S. 325:Part 2 has taken Irish conditions into account.

Where methods of construction are not covered by this standard or by any other Irish Standard, this should not be regarded as discouraging their use. The designer must be satisfied (by reference to appropriate manufacturer's literature and test reports issued by accredited authorities) that the materials and methods to be employed are such as to ensure a level of performance at least equal to that recommended in this standard.



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
