NSAI in exercise of the power conferred by section 16 (5) of the National Standards Authority of Ireland Act, 1996 (No. 28 of 1996) and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Dental equipment - High- and medium-volume suction systems (ISO 10637:1999)) Declaration,2000.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Dental equipment - High- and medium-volume suction systems (ISO 10637:1999). The Schedule comprises the text of EN ISO 10637:2000.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard EN ISO 10637:2000 or as I.S. EN ISO 10637:2000.
