- 1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Safety of Household and Similar Electrical Appliances, Part 2, Particular Requirements for Battery-Powered Shavers, Hair Clippers and Similar Appliances and their Charging and Battery Assemblies) Declaration, 1990.
- 2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Safety of Household and Similar Electrical Appliances, Part 2, Particular Requirements for Battery-Powered Shavers, Hair Clippers and Similar Appliances and their Charging and Battery Assemblies. The schedule comprises the text of EN 60335-2-19:1989 plus Common Modifications.
- (2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN 60335-2-19: 1990 or as I.S./EN 60335-2-19: 1990.

BRIEF HISTORY

The proposal to endorse the second edition of IEC Publication 335-2-19, document CENELEC/TC 61 (SEC) 455, was circulated under the enquiry procedure in September 1985.

This proposal was discussed during the Zandvoort meeting in June 1986 when it was decided to submit a draft for EN 60 335-2-19 to the voting procedure. This procedure started in September 1988.

The text of this draft was ratified by the CENELEC Technical Board on the 7th of March 1989.
