Forfás in exercise of the power conferred by section 20 (3) of the Industrial Research and Standards Act, 1961 (No. 20 of 1961) and the Industrial Development Act, 1993 (No. 19 of 1993), and with the consent of the Minister for Enterprise and Employment, hereby declares as follows:

1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Information Technology – International Standardized Profile FOD26 – Open Document Format: Enhanced Document Structure – Character, Raster Graphics and Geometric Graphics Content Architectures – Part 1: Document Application Profile (DAP) (Regional Variant of ISO/IEC ISO 11181-1:1993)) Declaration, 1995.

2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Information Technology – International Standardized Profile FOD26 – Open Document Format: Enhanced Document Structure – Character, Raster Graphics and Geometric Graphics Content Architectures – Part 1: Document Application Profile (DAP) (Regional Variant of ISO/IEC ISO 11181-1:1993). The Schedule comprises the text of EN ISP 11181-1 : 1994.

(2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN ISP 11181-1:1995 or as I.S./EN ISP 11181-1:1995.

for adoption by the Unique Acceptance Procedure (UAP), in accordance with clause 4.6 of the CEN/CENELEC Internal Regulations, Part 2 of April 1990.

The result of the Unique Acceptance Procedure was positive.

For the time being this standard exists in the English version only.

This document is the first part of a multi-part Functional Standard identified in M-IT-02 as 'F/OD26 Open Document Format - Enhanced Document Format - Character raster graphics and geometric graphics content architectures'.
