This Part 2-3 is to be used in conjunction with EN 60730-1:2000 + A1:2004, Automatic electrical controls for household and similar use – Part 1: General requirements, and any subsequent amendments.

This Part 2-3 supplements or modifies the corresponding clauses in EN 60730-1 so as to convert that publication into the European Standard: Particular requirements for thermal protectors for ballasts for tubular fluorescent lamps.

Where this Part 2-3 states "addition", "modification" or "replacement", the relevant requirement, test specification or explanatory matter in Part 1 shall be adapted accordingly.

Where no change is necessary, this Part 2-3 indicates that the relevant clause or subclause applies.
