- 1. This instrument may be cited as the Standard Specification (Identification cards machine readable passport (ISO/IEC 7501-1:1993)) Declaration, 1996.
- 2. (1) The Specification set forth in the Schedule to this declaration is hereby declared to be the standard specification for Identification cards machine readable passport (ISO/IEC 7501-1:1993). The Schedule comprises the text of EN ISO/IEC 7501-1: 1995.
- (2) The said standard specification may be cited as Irish Standard/EN ISO/IEC 7501-1:1996 or as I.S./EN ISO/IEC 7501-1:1996.
- 3. (1) The Standard Specification (Identification Cards Machine Readable Travel Documents Part 1: Machine Readable Passports (ISO/IEC 7501-1:1991)) Declaration, 1994 is hereby revoked.
- (2) Reference in any other standard specification to the Instruments hereby revoked and to Irish Standard/EN 27501-1:1994 thereby prescribed, shall be construed, respectively, as references to this Instrument and to Irish Standard/EN ISO/IEC 7501-1:1996.
