

This European Standard is to be used together with EN 60335-2-30, Household and similar electrical appliances - Safety - Part 2-30: Particular requirements for room heaters. It was established on the basis of EN 60335-2-30:2003, which is to be used together with EN 60335-1:2002. Amendments and revisions of EN 60335-1 and EN 60335-2-30 have also to be taken into account and the dates when such changes become applicable will be stated in the relevant amendment or revision of these standards.

This standard supplements or modifies the corresponding clauses of EN 60335-2-30, so as to convert it into the European Standard: Safety requirements for cab heaters for vehicles.

NOTE 1 The following numbering system is used:

- subclauses, notes, tables and figures that are numbered starting from 101 are additional to those in EN 60335-1;
- subclauses, notes, tables and figures that are additional to those in EN 60335-2-30 are numbered starting from 201 and are prefixed with the letter Z;
- additional annexes to those in EN 60335-2-30 are lettered AAA, BBB, etc.

NOTE 2 The following print types are used:

- requirements: in roman type;
- test specifications: in italic type;
- notes: in small roman type.

Words in **bold** in the text are defined in Clause 3. When a definition concerns an adjective, the adjective and the associated noun are also in bold.
